Mai 7ed – 12ed

2009 Visit

May 7th – 12th

We shall be travelling to Brittany on Thursday the 7th May, which is the weekend **after** the bank holiday and Spring Festival. We will travel to Plymouth to catch the overnight boat at 22.00 hours and returning on Monday night the 11th of May, docking at Plymouth at 21.30 hours and arriving in Newport in the early hours of Tuesday morning. During the visit, we will travel to the city of Quimper and the ancient town of Locronan.

The estimated cost of the trip at the present time is £80 each for adults and £40 for young people under 18 – this includes a shared cabin on the outward journey. To confirm your booking, you should complete the form attached to this newsletter, and return it complete with a deposit of £10 per adult and £5 for those under 18. The form and deposit/s should be with Julian Orbach by the 8th April, with the remainder of the money paid by the end of April. There may be more applicants than the places available, and so the selection will be based on the first deposits received.

The next meeting of the organising committee to which all are welcome will be at the Eco centre at 7.00p.m. on the 8th April. Those intending to travel should make every effort to attend so that they may receive information about the arrangements.

Insurance and Passport – the responsibility for arranging appropriate travel insurance rests with the individual, as does obtaining an EHIC card which ensures reduced-cost medical treatment in Brittany. Application forms are available from the Post Office and need to be submitted at least 14 days before travel. You will also need a valid passport.

Because the trip is heavily subsidised by the Association, it is essential that we raise some funds, and to this end a cake, preserves and plant stall will be held on Easter Saturday morning the 11th April on the Pharmacy forecourt, Market Street from 10a.m. onwards.
