

GD09 - PLANNING

- 1 Newport Town Council does **not** approve Planning Applications.
- 2 This is the responsibility of the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park Authority (PCNPA).
- 3 Newport Council's role is that of a statutory consultee alone.
- 4 The Town Council, at its meetings, reviews planning applications and makes site visits wherever possible in response to requests by PCNPA.
- 5 Any decision on an Application shall be by a show of hands unless in the Chairman's opinion it should be a secret ballot.
- 6 Members of the public are welcome to attend any Planning Meeting and, with the Chairman's permission speak on any item on the Agenda.
- 7 The time allowed for such a presentation will be 3 minutes unless the Chairman agrees otherwise.
- 8 Any group present at a meeting shall select a spokesperson to present their views.
- 9 Recommendations made by the Town Council are returned to the PCNPA Planning Department
- 10 Such recommendations are published on the Town Web Site.
