- 4.1. The accounts are as follows: Treasurers-£22,801.08, Grants & Projects-£10.00, 30-day savers-£36,923.10, Playing field-£9,086.07. Cllr. Harries proposed that all finances are paid, Cllr. McGarry seconded, all agreed.
- 4.2. <u>Budget for replacement trailer and more street market stalls</u> the market committee to bring a quote to the full town council meeting before the precept is agreed. The market roughly makes an income of £1k a year.
- 4.3. Parc y plant, Fields in Trust event on 27th April Cllrs. McGarry, Lewis and Letten to start looking into organising this event.

5. Adolygiad ariannol / Financial review

- 5.1. Receipts and payments The Clerk explained that the 3rd quarter figures are not complete yet as the end of this quarter is the end of December. Income for the 3rd quarter is mainly from the street market, VAT return and new headstone. The 3rd and final precept has just been received. The expenditure is mainly monthly direct debits which include energy, telephone, website, clerk's pay. Cllr. Harries proposed that the figures are correct and accepted, Cllr. Cleal seconded, all agreed.
- 5.2. Income/expenditure actuals to budget The Clerk explained again about the 3rd quarter not being complete. The underspend is showing at £20k but this is not an accurate reflection as there is a £15k internal transaction showing in the income, so the actual underspend is roughly £5k. Cllr. Harries proposed that the figures are correct and accepted, Cllr. Lloyd seconded, all agreed.
- 5.3. Bank reconciliation the first 2 quarters balance. The 3rd quarter has not been done yet.
- 5.4. Variances this is done at the end of the year.
- 5.5. <u>Capital and reserves accounts</u> The underspend from the previous financial year was discussed and approved on the 29th November. The Clerk has re-allocated the approved underspend. Cllr. Lewis proposed that the figures are correct and accepted, Cllr. McGarry seconded, all agreed.
- 5.6. Notes and assets this is done at the end of the year.
- 5.7. <u>High interest savings account</u> there is roughly £44k in the bank, currently receiving 1.3% interest. Cllr. Griffiths has been into the bank who have sent the Clerk an email with instructions on how to add a new signatory and change the name on the bank card.

8. Praesept am 2024 / Precept for 2024

8.1. The Clerk and Chair have draft suggestions for the precept which were read out to the council, including £400 for auditors, £12k for Clerk's salary (Clerk's appraisal is ongoing so this is a draft figure), £500 for subscriptions, £500 for gifts and donations, £1,000 to the playing field charity (advice was sought previously from OVW regarding being able to do this), £1,760 for councillor payments. There may be extra costs for the Christmas lights if they are reinstated in Maes Ingli and extend to the hall. Clerk's training cost to be discussed at the appraisal. The current inflation is 4.6% but has been higher throughout the year. After looking at the figures the draft precept sits at £33,124 which is roughly an increase of 9% on last year's precept.
