- <u>Draft minutes of the meeting held on the 18th January</u>. Proposed to be a correct record by Elaine, seconded by Morgan; all agreed Matters Arising.
 - 1.1. <u>Public meeting to set up a Community Land Trust</u>. Casey at Cwmpas had been given 3 possible dates, which were now either past or too soon. Sandra said that she thought the purpose of this was to establish what work was needed before a public meeting. Action Ros to contact Lowri to agree a new date with Casey.
 - 1.2. <u>Putting the Town Council's EoI for the Rectory on the Town Council website</u> to inform the public of the work by the Town Council Ros had sent the statement to Lowri, but this had not yet gone to John Griffiths for his advice before this is done. Action Lowri, please
 - 1.3. <u>Place Plan</u> Ros reported that the possibility of taking a Place Plan forward is now on the Housing T&FG agenda

- 1.4. Letter of thanks from the Town Council for help given in seeking to acquire the Rectory to Cwmpas, County Councillor Jon Harvey, Gaynor Toft PCC Head of Housing and Public Protection, and Julian Brewer. Draft sent to Lowri by Ros. Action Lowri, please
- **1.5**. <u>Open Reach Building</u> We have heard that there are no immediate plans to dispose of the building. Action: Lowri, please reply that we would wish to be notified before this happens.
- 2. Email from Casey (Cwmpas) regarding the purchaser of the Rectory. Casey had asked whether the Town Council would wish Cwmpas to find out who has purchased the Rectory. The purpose would be so that the Town Council could consider whether to approach the new owner to enquire whether they have any interest in helping to meet community needs on the site. Paddy wondered if there might be an issue as the Town Council is a planning consultee. Action: Ros to request that this be put on the Town Council's agenda for discussion.
- 3. <u>Response to draft Eol for Bethlehem and request for time.</u> The Agent had written to say that to comply with Charity law they were obliged to put the property up for auction for transparency. Our reading is that they are obliged only to get the best price. Paddy said that the proceeds of sale could only be used for charitable purposes. Ros expressed extreme disappointment with the situation. After discussion about possibilities for further action, it was decided to do no more.
- 4. <u>Mary's Farmhouse land.</u> It was not known whether Lowri had written to Gaynor Toft to find out from Mary's Farmhouse if the land is on the market again, and if so, explore the possibility of the County Council acquiring this for 100% affordable housing. Action: Ros to find out from Lowri if the thank you letter has been sent

Dear all,

I'd like to thank you for the below email on Thursday, which identified the following disability access issues in Newport. Please allow me to address each issue you listed below, as I see it so far.

• Wheelchair access - Parrog Road to Maes Ingli footpath – This is classed as an urban footpath and has had the bollard in place since at least 2009, where it can be seen on Google Maps. I have contacted other officers within the Highways department to find out why the bollard was put in place, but don't currently have an answer.

- Wheelchair access in the vicinity of the Chemist and Elements on Market Street The pavement/walls here appear to be private property. The simplest way to improve wheelchair access would be to demolish the walls, but the owners may not want to do this. There is a ramp at the Pharmacy entrance and a lowered kerb nearby.
- Access issue with steps by Post Office The Post Office is private property. Any issues with the steps would need addressing by the building owners. There is a crossing nearby and this has red tactile paving, as appropriate.
- Wheelchair access Parrog Yard development on Parrog Road These were properties built by Wales & West Housing in 2019, and as such, the land has not been adopted by Pembrokeshire County Council yet. This means the pavements shown on film would need dropped kerbs with appropriate tactile paving put in by Wales & West Housing. We can only carry out this work on adopted roads. Any queries about adoption should be addressed to Highways Adoption via highwaysadoption@pembrokeshire.gov.uk.

I'm happy to assist in any way I can, but I am unable to help at present beyond the advice given. I have copied my colleague Emma Lewis into this email so that she is aware of the discussions. Can I please ask that in future you email <u>accessofficer@pembrokeshire.gov.uk</u> so that we both see it?
